

## **Brilliant Responds to COVID-19** **LSRPs Continue to Oversee Remediation**

The health and safety of our team is our top priority during this pandemic. Taking the proper precautions will mitigate the risk of infection and go a long way towards containing our good health and work. All staff members of *Brilliant* continue to work remotely and travel to project sites in single passenger vehicles, while maintaining social distancing and wearing a mask. These are not normal procedures for the oversight of remediation, however these are not normal times.

NJ Governor Murphy recently signed [Executive Order No. 122](#) directing, among other things, that all non-essential construction in New Jersey cease until further notice by 8PM April 10, 2020. The Executive Order including specific provisions to allow a non-essential construction project to proceed if it is being undertaken to address an environmental emergency, remediate a discharge of contamination, and/or respond to a threat to human health and safety. Remediation of contaminated sites in NJ should be able to continue, however each site should be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.

On April 21, 2020, NJDEP Compliance & Enforcement issued a Compliance Alert in regards to COVID-19 ([#2020-08](#)) to provide direction to any person or entity effected by the circumstances. Included is an ability to request guidance from the NJDEP on a case-by-case basis, which could include extensions or waivers, however in the absence of direct NJDEP approval, all deadlines and permit requirements remain in force. In the event that non-compliance cannot be avoided due to the Public Health Emergency created by COVID-19, notification is required within two (2) business days of discovery through the DEP Hotline, unless shorter time frames are required by statute, regulation or permit.

### **Brilliant's Big Hurdle in Reorganization Plan**

As Brilliant has reported on May 13, 2019, we filed for Chapter 11 Reorganization under Bankruptcy Protection and on April 30, 2020, the Disclosure Statement and Plan will be approved by the Courts. A major hurdle

of this process is Brilliant had to secure approval of the plan by secured and unsecured creditors, most importantly receiving 50% of the unsecured creditors approval. This was not an easy process, as *Brilliant* had to receive approval of the plan by the creditors that *Brilliant* owed substantial sums of money and the plan will not pay out the entire portion of monies owed. Not an easy feat, but *Brilliant* has successfully received enough votes and we must thank the following for their support and confidence, as they represent our only team members going forward.

### **NJDOH Electronic System**

NJDOH has developed a new online electronic system for Indoor Environmental Consultants. Once implemented all consultants will be required to submit Indoor Environmental Health Assessments (IEHAs) and all related attachments through this new system. The following information must be provided to NJDOH by April 30th:

- First Name, Last Name and email address of all individuals who will be entering and uploading all IEHA data and attachments;
- First Name, Last Name and email address of all individuals approved to conduct IEHAs for your company; and
- Please indicate which staff will be responsible for the final submission of the IEHA.
