**Site Remediation Professional Licensing Board Announcements
regarding the LSRP Annual Fee, Upcoming Renewals, and the
Suspension of Certain Renewal Requirements**

LSRP Annual Fee: Invoices for the LSRP Annual Fee are due by January 16, 2021. The invoice may be paid via mail or online. Please follow the instructions on the invoice to make a payment.

Understanding that some LSRPs are working remotely, the Board has asked all LSRPs to look out for the invoice at the address you have indicated as your official address for Board correspondence. Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26I-2.10(d), an LSRP shall notify the Board of any change in contact information within 15 days of the change. Simply email the Board if your contact information has changed.

LSRPs who do not receive an invoice by December 4, 2020 should first contact their employer's business office or mailroom to determine if an invoice was received. If no invoice has been received, email the Board with Subject line "LSRP Annual Fee - Your Last Name or License Number" and a copy of the invoice will be emailed to you.

It is particularly important that you pay your LSRP Annual Fee on time and ensure your contact information is correct, as many licenses are up for renewal in the next few months, and renewal notifications and invoices will not be sent until the LSRP Annual Fee is paid.

Reminder about License Renewal: An LSRP's license renewal application period is 90 to 120 days before the license expiration date. If the LSRP Annual Fee has been paid, the Board will send renewal instructions to each LSRP in an email approximately two weeks before the renewal period begins. Renewal requirements must be met, the renewal invoice paid, Continuing Education Credits earned, and the renewal application and all supporting documentation received ninety (90) days before the license expiration date. The Renewal Fee invoice will be sent via U.S. Mail approximately two weeks before the renewal period begins.

The Renewal application form is a fillable PDF that can be accessed on the SRPL Board website at www.nj.gov/lspbboard/board/licensure/lrsp_license_renewal_application.pdf?v1_5 (version 1.5, dated 5/30/2018). The application form, OSHA certificates, continuing education credit certificates, and any other supporting documents must be attached to the email as one single PDF document and emailed to the Board.

Suspension of Certain Renewal Requirements: Pursuant to a June 18, 2020 temporary rule modification, the requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:26I-4.3 have been modified to allow an LSRP whose license renewal is due on or before December 31, 2021 to fulfill all necessary credit hours through approved courses offered in an alternative verifiable learning format. This means the 18-credit limit on these types of courses is temporarily suspended. LSRPs will qualify for license renewal provided that all the other requirements in N.J.A.C. 7:26I-2.11 have been met.

Brilliant can assist with Free Product Recovery and Short Term Remedial Action

As per a recent listserv from the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) they have been receiving Ground Water Remedial Action Permit (RAP) applications for sites where free and residual product have not been properly remediated in accordance with the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation [N.J.A.C. 7:26E-5.1(e)]. NJDEP further states, Active System Ground Water RAP Applications have included proposals for final long-term remedies for free product recovery in the form of socks/sorbent pads, High Intensity Targeted (HIT)/ Enhanced Fluid Recovery (EFR) events, and/or manual recovery (e.g., bailing) of free product in impacted wells. These methods of free product recovery as per NJDEP are only acceptable as short-term interim remedial measures (IRMs) when source material (i.e., residual product in soil) is being investigated and remediated.

At sites where free product is present, the source area should be fully investigated and remediated. Sporadic recovery of free product is highly effective utilizing *Brilliant's* Multi-Phase Recovery (MPR), also known as HIT or EFR mobile systems, with availability today to assist you with site remedial action assistance. Whether a daily event or longer, *Brilliant* can mobilize to your project site, extract total fluids, with liquid storage of up to 500 gallons and disposal coordination possible.
