Site Remediation Program Annual SRRA Fee Calculation Report

Pursuant to the Administrative Requirements for the Remediation of Contaminated Sites (ARRCS, N.J.A.C. 7:26C), the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) is to prepare each year an "Annual Site Remediation Reform Act Program Fee Calculation Report."

The report is to include the information contained in the annual budget submission to the Department of the Treasury, the numbers of contaminated areas of concern and of contaminated media, the base contaminated area of concern fee, the contaminated area of concern fee for each of the four categories, and the contaminated media fee that shall be due and payable. Additionally, the report is to include the factors used to calculate the remedial action permit fee for each remedial action permit activity, as well as the Annual Remedial Action Permit Fee for each type of Remedial Action Permit. A Notice is to be published in the New Jersey Register that includes a summary of the report and its Site Remediation Reform Act Program budget, and the NJDEP is also required to post the report on its website.

The Notice regarding the "Annual Site Remediation Reform Act Program Fee Calculation Report" was published in the May 3, 2021 New Jersey Register. Additional information is available on the NJDEP website at www.nj.gov/dep/srp/fees.

Responsible parties should be aware that for Annual Remediation Fees and Annual Remedial Action Permit Fees, the fee listed on the invoice is applicable.

For persons completing an initial online Annual Remediation Fee Form for new cases, the form must be submitted by June 30, 2021 in order for the Fiscal Year 2020 annual remediation fees to apply. Forms submitted on or after July 1, 2021 will be subject to the Fiscal Year 2022 annual remediation fees.

For persons submitting Remedial Action Permit activity documents (application, modification, transfer, termination), the document must be administratively complete and postmarked by June 30, 2021 to apply the Fiscal Year 2020 fees. Documents submitted on or after July 1, 2021 will be required to apply the Fiscal Year 2022 fee.

NJDEP Issues Policy Update on A-901 License Requirements

The Policy statement **updated** - need for LSRPs and SSEs to have an A-901 license at site remediation sites

In consideration of P.L. 2019, c. 397, often referred to as the “Dirty Dirt law,” enacted January 21, 2020, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has updated its existing Policy Statement: Licensed Site Remediation Professionals and Certified Subsurface Evaluators Do Not Need to Have an A-901 License When Overseeing Remediation (available at <https://www.nj.gov/dep/srp/guidance/archive/>).

This updated policy further clarifies the situations when Licensed Site Remediation Professionals and Certified Subsurface Evaluators do not need to have an A-901 license and or Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) when overseeing remediation, as well as those situations when an A-901 license is required.

Brilliant can assist with Free Product Recovery and Short Term Remedial Action

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) have been receiving Ground Water Remedial Action Permit (RAP) applications for sites where free and residual product have not been properly remediated in accordance with the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation [N.J.A.C. 7:26E-5.1(e)]. NJDEP states, Active System Ground Water RAP Applications have included proposals for final long-term remedies for free product recovery in the form of socks/sorbent pads, High Intensity Targeted (HIT)/ Enhanced Fluid Recovery (EFR) events, and/or manual recovery (e.g., bailing) of free product in impacted wells. These methods of free product recovery as per NJDEP are only acceptable as short-term interim remedial measures (IRMs) when source material (i.e., residual product in soil) is being investigated and remediated.

At sites where free product is present, the source area should be fully investigated and remediated. Sporadic recovery of free product is highly effective utilizing *Brilliant's* Multi-Phase Recovery (MPR), also known as HIT or EFR mobile systems, with availability today to assist you with site remedial action assistance.
